and social skills
for young people**

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The aim of the **Erasmus + project** is to develop professional and social skills against the background of the **internationalization of professions and markets**. An inadequate adaptation of skills to the current and **future needs of companies** causes distortions on the labor market and leads to unnecessary waiting times at the start of work even in times of a shortage of skilled workers and limits the employment rate.

The **target** group is especially **students and trainees at vocational schools** in Poland, Germany and Italy. Another target group are teachers and trainers in vocational training.

What does the MIKO project offer?

1. **Learning model** for students and apprentices of professional training with 36 didactic modules divided into themes like
 - ✓ action strategies in a multicultural team, efficient communication and conflict resolution in an international context
 - ✓ tackling the change: mobility and flexibility on the labor market, intercultural skills in the workplace,
 - ✓ additive tools in a new environment: initiative, empowerment and sharing and teaching a profession in an international perspective.
2. **Training course** for teachers, trainers and tutors on the challenges of teaching today and tomorrow.
